**HALLOWEEN:** Parties will be next Monday afternoon in each individual classroom. Individual teachers will send notes IF they want anything brought in for parties. Since the parties won't be until the afternoon, students in grades **1-8** will need to **BRING their costume** to school to change into after lunch. **PreK and Kindergarten students may wear their costumes to school**, but they must be able to go about their normal day, i.e. sit at their desk, play outside, go to the restroom by themselves, etc. PreK & K students will have PE first thing in the morning so please bear that in mind in regards to costumes. **As a reminder, weapons are not allowed with costumes. Neither is fake blood or other gory make-up or costumes.** Please use sound judgment when picking out costumes to wear to your Catholic school.

**PARADE:** The annual Halloween parade will take place on Monday the 31st (**weather permitting**). Students will leave St. Paul School just before 1:00 p.m and walk east on Elk Street towards Lobo's, north on Wauponsie towards Cafe 110, west on Tremont towards 66 Licks, and then south on West Street back towards the church and school. Family and friends are welcomed to watch from anywhere on the route.
