

MASKING: With the Diocesan decision to make masks optional at school, thereby removing a COVID-19 prevention layer, social distancing will now be more important than ever. Though masks are no longer required, there are times your child will be asked to wear one for a short time at school if the proper social distancing can't be enforced. For example:

- If your child is working one-on-one with their teacher, they will be asked to wear a mask during that time.
- If students are doing group work or projects that require they be in close quarters, they will be asked to wear a mask during those times.
- Students that are returning to school after their five day quarantine (positive case or close contacts) must wear a mask through their tenth day. If they chose not to do so, then they must stay home until their full ten day quarantine is over.
- Students on buses are required by law to wear masks.

**If you would like your child to stay masked throughout the school day, please let the office or your child's teacher know.

Unfortunately COVID-19 has not gone away, and we must continue our efforts at school to keep our students, faculty, and staff safe and healthy. We ask for your continued patience through ever-changing policies that are handed down to us and that students, families, faculty, and staff continue to be respectful of each other.
