LIVING STATIONS: Students in grades 5-8 will be performing the Living Stations of the Cross tomorrow after the 8:30 school Mass at St. Paul Church. Grades 2-4 will also make up the choir. The seventh grade will be working on proportions and the eighth grade will be factoring quadratic equations.
