

## St. Paul School Newsletter 5.18.23

**REGISTRATION:** Packets for next school year went home yesterday. Families that return paperwork and book fees before the last day of school will receive a discount on their oldest child's book fees. Please see the note that went home with the packet for additional information. Again, some fees and tuition were raised for next school year.

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** Never let the cost of tuition stop you from enrolling your child at St. Paul School. There are four options for financial aid for students attending St. Paul. The Juli Sullivan Memorial Scholarship Fund and the Paul & Pat Vogt Memorial Scholarship Fund are exclusive and open only to students of St. Paul School. Both of these funds have the ability to award multiple scholarships each year. To inquire about benefiting from these funds, simply call the school office and ask to speak to Mr. Morehouse. The Spalding Scholarship is available through the Diocese of Peoria and requires application through the FACTS system. This scholarship, partial and full, is awarded by the Diocese. Finally, there's the Empower Illinois Scholarship program. To apply for these funds, you can visit empowerillinois.org and click on the "apply" button.

**STEWARDSHIP:** This coming Sunday is our last Stewardship Mass of the school year! Mass parts have been handed out at school. Those students that participate in the Mass by reading, serving, singing in the choir, etc will get a COMFY day on Monday the 22nd.

**CLEANING DAY:** Wednesday will be classroom clean up day! This will also be a COMFY day for all students. Parents can send in cleaning supplies with their children - buckets, rags, wipes, cleaning sprays, etc. **Please do not send caustic materials on the bus.**

Awards will follow at the church. Families are encouraged to attend if they are able.
