If you attend the meeting, your child(ren) will be rewarded with a COMFY DAY the next day and also the following Thursday!

HARVEST DAYS BREAKFAST: Due to rising COVID statistics we are looking at adjusting the originally planned September breakfast. More details will be sent home soon! Please keep the September 19th date on your calendar though!

SAFE ENVIRONMENT: Any parent that will be working at an event this year needs to complete the Diocesan "Safe Environment" online training. This entails creating an online account, watching a video, and completing an online background check. Trainings need to be completed prior to volunteering. VACCINATIONS: For any students that have received the COVID-19 vaccine, we ask that parents please send in verification of vaccination. This will be kept in your child's school records. It's important we have proof of vaccination on file in case there is an exposure in the classroom or to that individual student as they would **not** have to quarantine unless symptoms arose. If your child has had a known exposure to someone with COVID-19, please keep them home and alert the school.

OGS BUS: There will be **NO** afternoon Odell Grade School bus next Friday, September 3 as Odell will dismiss early that day. Students will need a ride home in the afternoon. After care is also available until 5:30p.

SAFE JOURNEYS ILLINOIS: Representatives from Safe Journeys Illinois will be coming to speak to individual classrooms once a week beginning September 1. They will provide 30 minute presentations to students over the course of six weeks on topics ranging from bullying (grades 3-8) to safe touch (grades K-2).
